The lake is 9 miles long and 3/4 mile wide with a maximum depth of 66 ft. in the center just out from the campground. Conesus Lake Campground is just 30 miles south of Rochester with it's many interesting things to see and do. We

## SWIMMING AND SAFETY RULES

The swimming facilities at Conesus Lake Campground are not supervised by a lifeguard, only by an adult. In place of on-site supervision, this facility has established a series of safeguards to be followed by all guests.

Never swim alone. A minimum of two adults, 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use. There is no substitute for adequate supervision. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. A child shall be kept from going into the pool unaccompanied by an adult. In case of emergency, notify the facility operator. No bottles, cans, or food is allowed at the pool, pool patio, or the lake. The management is not liable for lost, damaged or stolen property nor for any injury to any person. The pool may only be used during posted hours of operation.

Only registered guests may use the swimming facilities. Your safety is important to us.

### IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Dial 911 for fire or ambulance.

### CONTROLLED ACCESS GATE

Admittance between 11:00 pm and 8:00 am will be by gate key card only. You can obtain a key card from the office for a \$20.00 deposit, refundable on return of the key card.

You can exit from camp at any time by approaching the gate slowly. Your car activates the gate and it will close behind you. Gate is set to admit one car only. Do not follow another car through because the gate will close on your car. **Do not admit anyone into the campground you do not know.**

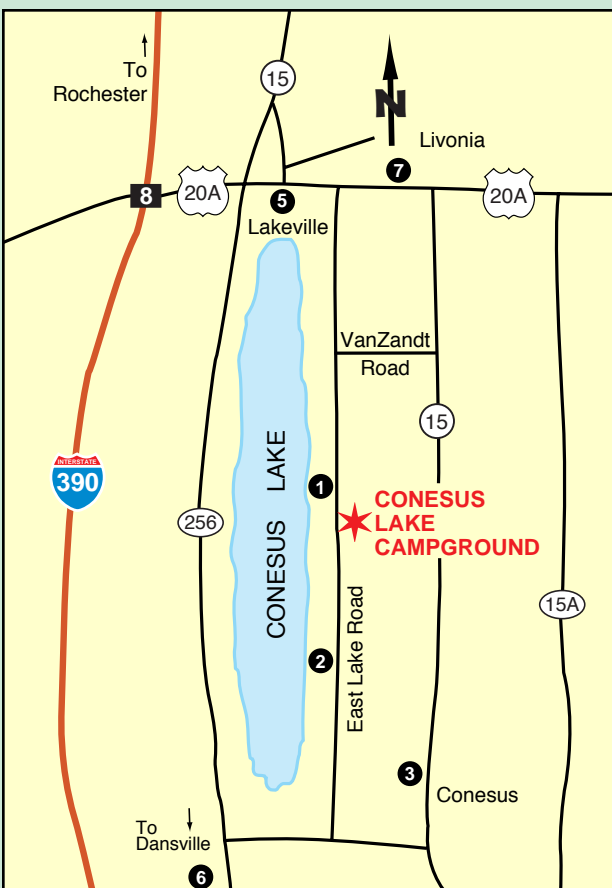


## CAMP STORE

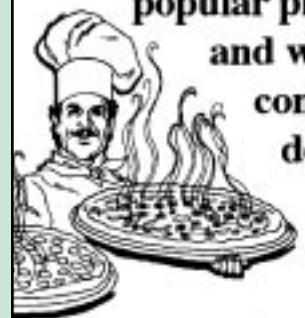

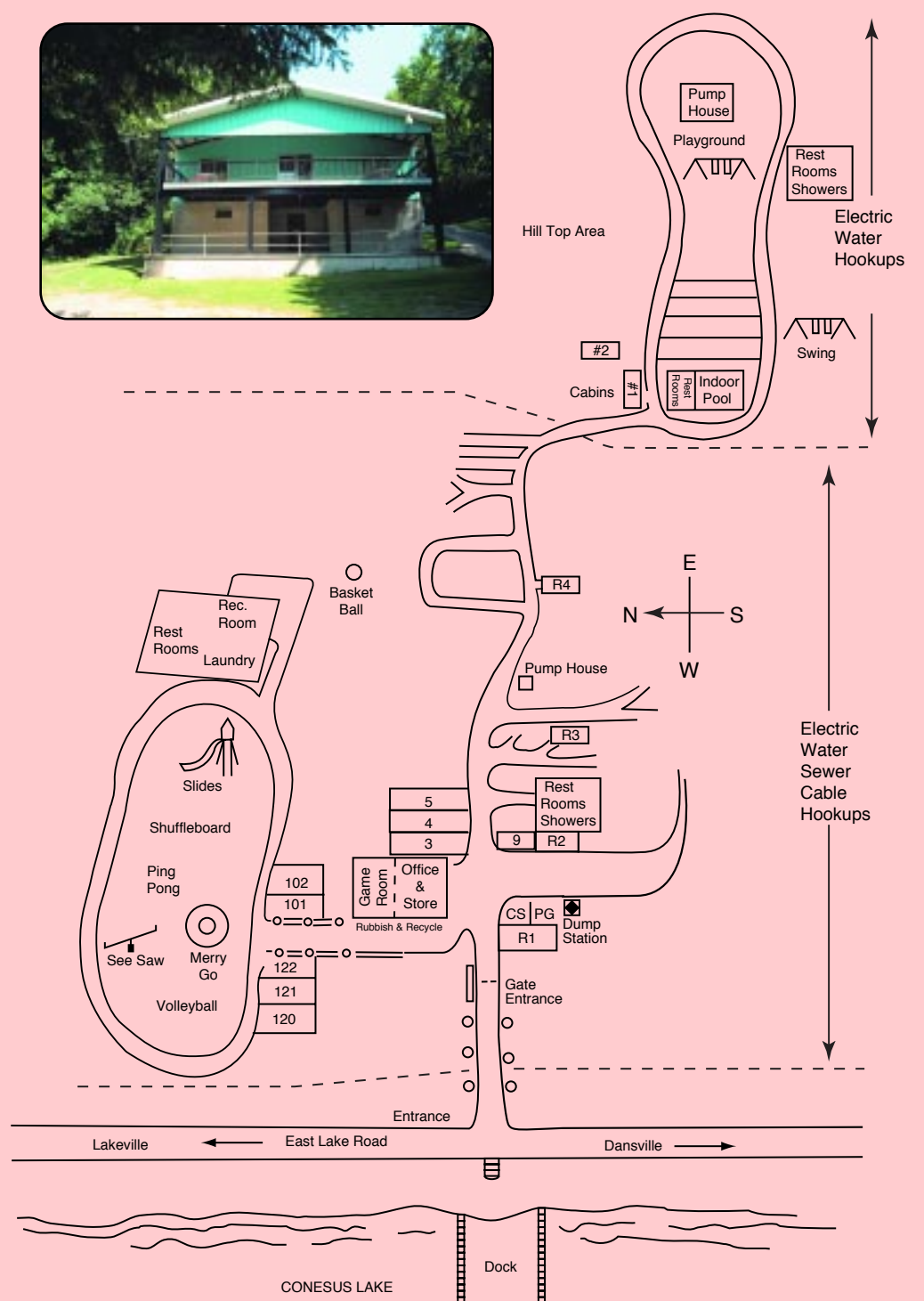

# CONESUS LAKE CAMPGROUND

Located on a hill overlooking the east side of Conesus Lake.  
Tent & camper sites are large, shaded and spacious.  
R.V. sites have sewer, water & electric.



## 2009 CAMPING FEES

Standard camp fees are for two adults and children under age sixteen. Each extra person is assessed a \$6.00 per day charge, holidays \$10.00. There is a maximum of five people per site. Only one camping unit per site. The camping day begins at 3:00 p.m and ends at 1 p.m.

Full deposit is required. Specific site reservations are subject to substitution if previous occupant decides to extend their stay.

A reservation may be cancelled up to 10 days prior to your scheduled arrival and a refund, less a \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. Sorry, holiday weekends are not refundable.

Camping is an outdoor activity, therefore, we do not give refunds due to discomforts of nature.

## GUEST AND VISITOR INFORMATION

All guests and visitors must register at the camp office. We are required by law to know and register the exact people in our park at all times.

Fees, Per Person: Daytime ..... \$3.00 Overnight ..... \$6.00  
Holidays: Daytime \_\_\_\_ \$5.00 Overnight \_\_\_\_ \$10.00  
All cars must have a pass affixed to your rearview mirror at all times.

## BOAT DOCKAGE

\$10.00 per day - 16' & under; \$1.00 per foot over 16' additional. Maximum 19' boat. No party boats. All boats must have a pass which must be displayed on all boats tied up at the campground dock. These passes are issued at the campground office. Obtain your pass before you tie up to the dock.

## ROW BOAT RENTAL

\$25.00 for half day  
\$40.00 for whole day  
\$240.00 per week  
If you care to bring a motor, row boat is licensed and will take up to a 15 horse engine.

\$40.00 deposit is required on all equipment, refundable upon return of equipment in good condition.



## CAMPGROUND REFUSE DISPOSAL RULES

THERE WILL BE NO TRASH REMOVAL AT CAMP SITES.  
Trash must be placed in dumpster near store.



## KYACK RENTALS

\$15.00 per hour

\$5.00 each additional hour

Deposit will be required, refundable upon return in good condition.



## ELECTRIC BOAT RENTALS

\$20.00 per hour

Deposit will be required, refundable upon return in good condition.

## CAMPGROUND RULES

A "day" is a period of not more than 24 hours ending in any case at 1 p.m.

No dangerous or offensive animals are allowed.

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and may not be taken onto the beach.

No weapons or fireworks are allowed.

Offensive conduct of any kind is prohibited. Making noise between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. or undue noise at any time is classified as offensive conduct.

Children must be controlled by parents at all times. All children and teenagers must be at their campsite by 11 p.m. unless with parents.

Cars may not be driven faster than 5 mph anywhere on the grounds. Cars may be parked only parallel with the public highway, never facing up or down the hill in any appreciable degree.

No washing of any kind is permitted at outdoor faucets. Hot water may not be taken from the shower buildings.

Any person destroying or cutting trees will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law for vandalism and malicious mischief. Trees shall not be cut down or disfigured. Damages are collectible for cutting down or disfiguring a black walnut tree in the sum of \$500, any other tree, \$200.

Campfires shall never be left unattended and completely put out when leaving camp. When you make your campfire, please put it in the same place as previous campfires. Firewood can be purchased at the campground store.
