NOTICE to All Campers

for

Camping during the COVID-19 Pandemic

issued 5/8/2020

To help ensure the health and safety of all camping participants, staff and the community during the COVID-19 pandemic, campers **MUST** abide by these guidelines and conditions.

Use of Campground Facilities

The following facilities, amenities and uses are prohibited at this time:

- × Swimming pools and beaches
- × Recreation halls
- × Playgrounds / sport courts & equipment
- × Pavilions
- × Social gatherings of any size (in addition to campsite occupants). Campers shall generally stay at their own site and not congregate at other campsites or places.
- × Daytime visitation from guests not intended as occupants for original overnight use.

The following facilities are permissible for use:

- ✓ Campground operated food service on a takeout or delivery basis only for consumption at individual campsites.
- ✓ Toilet and bathhouse facilities subject to maintaining 6-foot separation from other campground users or use of a face mask when allowable.
- ✓ Laundry facilities and camp store subject to maintaining social distancing/mask use.

If you begin to feel ill with COVID-19 symptoms (fever above 100°F, cough or shortness of breath) you must self isolate immediately and contact your medical provider.

Failure to comply with the above may result in the revocation of the campground's Permit to Operate and may result in additional action(s) by the campground to your camping status.

Thank you for your understanding and enjoy your stay at the campground.

Tips for reducing your risk of COVID-19

- Practice social distancing and wear masks covering the mouth and nose while in public
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water or use hand sanitizer when soap and water are not available
- Wipe frequently touched surfaces with disinfecting wipes or other EPA approved disinfectants
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue and wash hands immediately after using them.
- Stay away from people who may be sick
